Notes

Core +2 Tuition Discount - Applies to students taking the Core plus 2 additional classes (full-year classes only, excludes study hall and clubs).

Sibling Tuition Discount - Applies to families with two or more students enrolled in Core, \$100 tuition discount per subsequent sibling.

Class Offerings - Not all classes shown are offered at each location. Please refer to each location's course schedule.

Book Costs - Estimated book costs shown are for new books only. Costs may be reduced by purchasing used or borrowing. Note: Some books are used over multiple years and need only be purchased once.

Study Hall - Any student not in class and on campus is required to register for, pay for, and be in study hall (including the lunch hour).

Tuition Payments - Tuition payments are due in 8 equal installments on the 1st of each month, May 2024 through December 2024. A student is considered fully enrolled as soon as the first tuition payment has been received. Tuition payments must be current (first four payments made) to attend the first day of classes. Ten month payment plans are available. Check with your Campus Administrator.

IMPORTANT/PLEASE READ: We consider a family's registration request to be a well-intentioned commitment to take all requested classes and pay all fees associated with them. We assume that families do not register for classes they are likely to drop later. The FULL tuition balance upon enrollment is due, regardless of whether the student attends the class(es) for the full school year or not. Students seats are secured and students are considered enrolled once the first tuition payment is made. Unpaid students may be removed from classes June 1st if there is a waitlist.
